Duration of Meeting:

Vendor's participation will be from April 12, 2019 to April 13, 2019.

Vendor Set-Up and Breakdown: The ABD will let you know 15 days prior to conference when Vendor and their staff may set up their tables, booths or other marketing materials, as needed.

Vendor Fees:

Vendor agrees that all fees promised for participation in the ABD annual meeting must be paid by February 1, 2019. Vendor may not participate in the ABD annual meeting if the vendor fee is not paid by the start of the meeting.

Miscellaneous:

Cancellation:

The ABD reserves the right to cancel the Annual Meeting at any time up until 7 days prior to the meeting start date. Nothing will be reimbursed to the Vendor for any expenses incurred as a result of the cancellation of the meeting. In the event of a cancellation all fees paid to the ABD will returned to the Vendor.

Conflict of Interest

Vendors acknowledge that all speakers content will be reviewed for potential conflict of interest or bias. All Speakers must comply with CERP/PACE guidelines. Speakers will be required to add, modify or delete content in order to maintain compliance so attendees can receive CE credit. Speakers will be allowed to discuss Vendor's products in their presentations but no slides with the Vendor's logo will be allowed.

Sales:

The Vendor consents to personal jurisdiction in the state of California regardless of the state of incorporation of the Vendor and the fact that the meeting will be in Nevada.

2. The Vendor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the ADA harmless from any damages that the ABD may sustain in any manner through your breach of this agreement, and/or from your misconduct or negligence related to this meeting. The ABD may seek reimbursement from you any monies paid to third parties as a result of this subsection, provided that any monies sought shall be without prejudice whatsoever to the ABD’s other rights and remedies under this agreement or otherwise, at law or in equity.

The Vendor agrees to hold the ABD harmless for any personal injury that occurs to Vendor’s representatives during the meeting, travel before and after the meeting. The ABD will only be responsible for conduct of its officers and directors and not for any attendee of the meeting.

3. The ABD may change any term or provision in this letter upon written notice to the Speaker and/or Vendors.
